

10.4 Demonstrative pronouns / Δεικτικές αντωνυμίες

The demonstrative pronouns are used to indicate which entity the speaker refers to. The most common demonstrative pronouns are:

αυτός this	εκείνος that	τέτοιος such	τόσος so much, so many
αυτή	εκείνη	τέτοια	τόση
αυτό	εκείνο	τέτοιο	τόσο

The demonstrative pronouns follow the declensional pattern of the corresponding adjectives in -ος, -η, -ο or -ος, -α, -ο and agree in gender, number and case with the noun they refer to.

αυτός ο κύριος	this gentleman
εκείνη η κυρία	that lady
εκείνο το βιβλίο	that book
αυτά τα παιδιά	these children
